

# How to Protect Yourself and Your Organisation

## Supply Chain Attacks

### Understand your supply chain

Identify all third-party tools, integrations, and service providers with access to your data or systems



### Assess your suppliers

Understand what security controls are in place, and review service agreements to establish security expectations



### Review access controls

Apply least privilege to supplier accounts, and regularly review account permissions



### Maintain good cyber hygiene

Keep devices patched and updated, enable MFA everywhere and ensure passwords are unique and strong



### Monitor and prepare for incidents

Monitor accounts for unusual activity, and understand your suppliers incident response and recovery plan
